

2015 NSCB Christmas Concerts - Facts and FAQ

A Christmas Concerts website will once again be available this year, containing the following information and much more. Look for the “Christmas Concert Website” link on the www.nscband.org home page.

Advertising in Program

Advertising space is being sold for both the Christmas Concerts and the North Suburban Concert Band’s May 1st Pops Concert at the same time. Advertisers will receive a discounted price if they purchase ad space in both programs at this time.

Advertising is available to local businesses, professional services, home businesses, and so forth. All performers are encouraged to direct potential advertisers to the ad page on the [Christmas Concert website](http://www.nscband.org) or to sell advertising directly. Assistance is available by contacting advertising@nscband.org.

A business-card-sized ad – 3 ½” x 2” - is \$25 (\$35 for both programs); double that size is \$50 (\$70); ½ page is \$100 (\$140) and a full page is discounted at \$175 (\$250). Christmas programs are distributed to 1,250 people, including audiences and performers; Pops programs go to about 300. Visibility expands as programs are shared with friends and family, so ad exposure to the local market is very good. The NSCB retains the right to reject any material it deems inappropriate. Ad will be printed in grayscale only – no color.

Poinsettias

Each year, we decorate the stage and refreshment tables with red poinsettias. Performers may purchase one or more poinsettias in advance of the concerts, and then collect it/them to take home IMMEDIATELY after Sunday’s performance. The cost this year is again \$10.

Sales will begin on Nov. 22nd at NSCB and NSCC rehearsals. If TCYC parents wish to purchase one, they should contact **Shirley Paroczai** (see Contacts).

Schedule (Concert Weekend – Andover High School)

Friday, December 4:

6:00 pm - Stage setup; volunteers needed for risers and other things

7:00 pm – Rehearsal begins (detailed schedule will be provided later)

(TCYC members may have different arrival and departure times.)

8:00pm (approx.) – Ticket swap in cafeteria

Saturday, December 5:

6:30 pm – Performer call time

7:00 pm – Auditorium doors open (no seats may be reserved prior to this time)

7:30 pm – Concert (Following the concert: Refreshments in the cafeteria.)

Schedule (Cont'd)

Sunday, December 6:

1:00 pm – Performer call time

1:30 pm – Auditorium doors open (no seats may be reserved prior to this time)

2:00 pm – Concert (Following the concert: Refreshments in the cafeteria.)

FOLLOWING THE CONCERT: Poinsettia distribution and set tear down in auditorium.

Seating

Seating is general admission. In order to be fair to all members of the audience, no saving of seats will be allowed in advance of the opening of the auditorium doors. These doors will be opened 30 minutes prior to each performance.

This rule will be strictly enforced, and coats or other items left on seats will be removed and placed on or near the stage just prior to the doors being opened.

(Exceptions may be made in the case of special needs seating. Please contact Scott McCullough (see Contacts) or confer with an usher if you or a family member require special accommodation.)

Tickets

For newcomers: one or both concerts usually sell out, so plan ahead!

Tickets are all \$10 each – all ages; Seating is general admission

Limited sales to performers begin Nov. 8th at rehearsals

4 tickets per performer – any combination of Saturday and Sunday

Please work out any “deals” with other performers on your own. The ticket sellers can’t make any special arrangements.

Open sales begin Nov. 18th

There will be a ticket swap in the Andover High School cafeteria at the “dress” rehearsal on Friday night, Dec. 4th at about 8pm.

Mail orders will be accepted in the order received and fulfilled after Nov. 18th. *Please be sure to indicate for which performance(s) you want your tickets, and include a check (payable to “NSCB”). If you want your tickets mailed to you, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope.*

Note: Mail orders received after Nov. 28th – if tickets remain – will be held at will call.

On-line ticket sales: Tickets will be available on-line this year from Nov. 18th through Dec. 4th via the NSCB website (www.nscband.org). Look for the special link for tickets after Nov. 18th. Credit cards and Paypal only. There will be a small processing fee *per ticket* for this service. **All tickets ordered online will be held at will call.**

Volunteers

Volunteers make a huge contribution to the success of the concerts each year. At least 8 are needed for each show – for ushering, refreshments, etc. Volunteers will be rewarded for their efforts with a free ticket to the Saturday or Sunday concert. The free ticket can be used by anyone – not just the volunteer – but volunteers should not plan on watching the concert at which they are working.

Volunteers will be asked to select their choice of a Saturday or Sunday ticket when they volunteer – by Nov. 22nd at the latest in any case. (If a volunteer chooses to work at both performances, he or she may request 2 tickets.)
